At SEABRAZ IPR & Corporate Law (“Seabraz”, “Firm”, “we”, “our”, or “us”), we are committed to protecting the privacy, confidentiality, and security of the personal information shared with us through our website, communications, consultations, and professional services.

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, store, process, and protect your information when you access our website, contact our team, or engage with our services. By using our website or submitting information to us, you agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy.

1. INFORMATION WE COLLECT
